Minutes of 2011 Annual Meeting

The 2011 annual meeting was held on April 22, 2011 at the Golden Corral at Kansas and I-44.

President Steven Rogers called the meeting to order at 7:05 with a few opening comments. The members present introduced themselves and their family. Due to the secretary position being vacant at the time of the 2010 annual meeting there were no minutes of that meeting available. Terry Twyman gave the Treasurer's report.

Special guests were introduced –

- Joe Mushrush, President of the American Red Angus Association and his wife Connie were present. Joe gave an update on what's happening with the National Board.
- Clint Berry, Commercial Marketing Representative for the Red Angus Association of America, gave a general update of what's happening in commercial marketing and provided comments on the upcoming feeder calf sales in north and south Missouri.
- The next item on the agenda was the election of new officers and directors for the 2011 – 2012 year:

President – Steven Rogers was nominated as president by Larry Ellison and was elected unanimously.

Vice President – Raymond Pace was nominated by Larry Ellison and was unanimously elected.

Secretary – Barbara Twyman was nominated by Raymond Pace. She was elected unanimously.

Treasurer – Larry Ellison was nominated and was elected unanimously.

Northeast Director – Dennis Jacobs was elected unanimously.

Northwest Director – Dwight Harper was elected unanimously.

Under new business, the following items were discussed:

- Field Day for September 25th at Diamante Ranch in Diamond, Missouri was discussed. Glenn Brown invited everyone to attend and promised an interesting day.
- Aaron Crosby suggested that the area directors should attempt to have area meetings with their member's prior to having state director meetings.
- Larry Ellison gave the dates for the Ozark Empire Fair open and junior shows and mentioned that anyone wanting to sponsor junior awards should contact him.
- Steven Rogers discussed the possibility of having a fall sale and discussed either having it in north Missouri or having it in south Missouri on October 15th in conjunction with the Missouri Simmental Association. He asked everyone to contact himself or Larry Ellison with any comments they might have about the fall sale.
