

Consignor Agreement:

As a consignor to the Missouri Red Angus 2011 Spring Sale, I agree to the following:

I, _____, authorize the Red Angus Association of America to bill my account, number _____ for any necessary charges resulting from the registration/transfers submitted by the Missouri Red Angus Association, on my behalf. The Missouri Red Angus Association has permission to sign and submit all necessary paperwork needed to complete the registration/transfer process. I agree to and will abide by the following Guidelines for the Sale.

All animals will sell with a guarantee by the seller as outlined in the Red Angus Association of America Code of Ethical Sale Practices. It is clearly understood that all warranties, guarantees and refunds on any animal not meeting the standards of the RAAA Rules and Regulations shall be made by the Seller to the Buyer upon proof of cattle not meeting the representations in the auction.

All persons who attend the sale do so at their own risk. The Seller, auction facility and Missouri Red Angus Association assume no liability for any accidents that may occur. Neither does the Seller, auction facility or Missouri Red Angus Association assume any liability for loss or injury to livestock due to theft, mysterious disappearance, sickness, improper handling or act of God. It is to be clearly understood that Missouri Red Angus Association and its representatives act only as a medium between the Buyer and Seller. The Missouri Red Angus will not be responsible for failure on the part of the Buyer and Seller to handle his obligations, any warranties or representation, express or implied, nor does the Missouri Red Angus Association assume financial obligations to collect or enforce collection of monies between parties. Any legal action, which may occur in exceptional cases, must be between the Buyer and Seller.

Interstate Health Papers prepared by an accredited veterinarian will be supplied by me to the Missouri Red Angus on each animal. All health papers must contain the pregnancy status on females sold as bred and the open status on open females. Health Certificates must be handed to the Missouri Red Angus on arrival at the sale facility.

The Seller will be responsible for original registration papers, transfer forms, breeding information and Health Papers before any animal is sold.

All lots that are consigned by the seller and does not arrive at the auction and does not sell will be assessed a commission based on the average selling price of the animal's class. I agree to pay this commission on any animals consigned by me that do not arrive and sell in this auction.

The stated terms above shall be a binding contract between the Buyer and Seller of each animal sold.
