



## 2011 Missouri Red Angus Spring Sale

### Sale Guidelines

#### Guidelines:

- 1) Cattle Condition and Appearance:
  - a) **All** cattle will be a Body Condition Score (BCS) of 5 or better. The Sale Committee will sift through all cattle to determine if they meet this requirement. Any cattle not meeting this standard of a BCS of 5 or better will not be allowed to sell.
  - b) **All** cattle must be clipped or torched no later than 8:00 a.m. sale day. Clipping/torching services will be provided Friday, April 22 at a per head rate.
- 2) All cattle must be in place and arrive with ear tags provided by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, April 22.
- 3) In order to sell a bull, a female must also be offered in the sale. Bulls will be sold through the ring, with a floor price set by the consignor indicated in the catalog. All bulls must be accompanied by a documented Breeding Soundness Exam. Red Angus-cross bulls may be offered granted they:
  - a) Are at least 50% Red Angus
  - b) The remaining genetics of the bull is provided
  - c) They are red or red white-faced in color.
  - d) Commission on all bulls will be at the same rate as for registered females.
- 4) The Sale Committee will select sale order on-site and post the sale order by 10:00 a.m. on sale day.
- 5) Know carriers of genetic defects will identified in the catalog.
- 6) Consignors are encouraged to provide footnotes and high-quality, digital photos of the animals to be sold.
