Maternal and performance..... who would have thought. The thing that would impress you most if you could just see him in person is to see a 2,000 lb. bull with such amazing athleticism. Moderate frame, depth, capacity, length, big boned, big footed, stucture, libido, disposition.....Gran Torino is running on all cylinders. Whether you want sons or daughters, take your pick. Gran Torino will move his progeny into the future. Mark and I feel so confident in Gran Torino and his future in the Red Angus breed we are donating 10 straws to be auctioned off to benefit the MORAA. We believe great bulls should be able to be used by all breeders. So we invite you to join us as we use Gran Torino to help move the Red Angus breed forward into the future of what nature has yet to show us in quality beef. 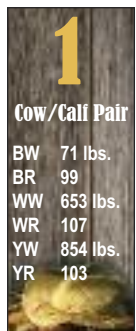

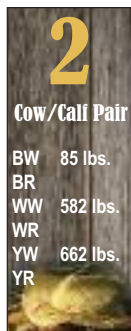

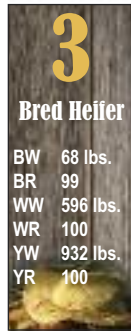


Majestic Rebella Y202 – Lot 2

A word why we chose to register these bred heifers in the Gelbvieh registry instead of the Red Angus registry. It's our opinion that the strength in the Red Angus registry is in the 1A & 1B classification. We believe if our Red Angus cattle are 87.5% - 100.0%, then the Red Angus registry brings out the strength of these animals EPDs. We also find the Gelbvieh Association (AGA) has done a great job with their registry for cross-bred and pure-bred categories. Even though both organizations are on a common base now, we see the effect of great Red Angus genetics showing a "lifting" effect in the AGA registry for Balancer™ cattle. Unfortunately, we experience the opposite effect for bringing Gelbvieh cattle into the Red Angus registry as CAT 3 animals. Top % ranking will be enhanced in the AGA, while Top% ranking will be lowered in the ARAA database. They are the same great animal, but why one registry (AGA) represents cross-bred animals better than the Red Angus registry is a bit puzzling to us.

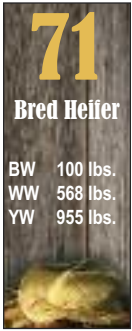

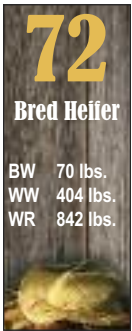

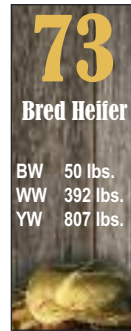

Lots 74-77: Registered Fall Bred Foundation ET Heifers

These next four lots represent some special embryo transfer work we've done with TransOva Genetics in Chillicothe, MO. We trust our story is clear enough to understand, but don't hesitate to ask questions.

Bachman Cattle Farms selected the #1 and #2 foundation cows from our cowherd. They are #1 and #2 for the reason that both have MPPA scores of 111, both have perfect feet, udders and gentle dispositions. Neither cow has ever been treated for sickness, only getting their regular vaccinations and deworming pours. Both animals have been perfect in having calves every 365 days and re-breeding in the first cycle when exposed to a bull. We call these the G104 and B1120 cow families. Two of the G104 heifers are full sisters and two of the B1120 heifers are full sisters. The G104 and B1120 heifers will be half-sisters to each other. Both are 50% Red Angus and Gelbvieh. We chose to register them in the Gelbvieh database and feel their potential is better represented in that database.

We aspirated them one time at TransOva and made 29 embryos between the two (all sex-sorted female Mission Statement P27 embryos) and have recorded 13 pregnancies. These two girls (with Mission Statement's help!) did a heck of a job converting eggs into embryos and viable pregnancies.

We are showcasing and selling four of our group. Two of the heifers will represent the G104 cow family and two will represent the B1120 cow family. They are pregnant to Gelbvieh PB94 bulls, so their offspring can be registered in the Gelbvieh database as Balancers™-60%. Each animal is Missouri Show-Me Select™ qualified – Tier 2.

Each bred heifer has been parent verified, Negative BVD-PI, and free of all tested genetic defects. 3 of the 4 score very high on their Tenderness DNA markers (9 out of 10).

Last comment: We took eight of these bred heifers back to TransOva to aspirate them to three great Gelbvieh bulls (JPDP Astro 407S, RID Collateral 2R and CIRS Decade 278U2) and they produced 114 embryos in two sessions. This is a great early indication how fertile they are and we are excited to work with their embryos to build on this great genetic foundation.
